The Susanville Indian Rancheria, is implementing a “Neighborhood Watch” Program for residents of the Rancheria. Neighborhood Watch is set-up for the safety of the residents of SIR. Over the last several months, crime and suspicious activity has occurred both on the lower and upper Rancheria. We are concerned Tribal Members, who want to ensure the safety of our Elders, Children, and residents of the S.I.R.

The Neighborhood Watch Program is a group of people living in the same area, who want to make the neighborhood safer by working together and in conjunction with the local law enforcement to reduce crime and improve their quality of life.

On Monday, January 18, 2016, a SIR Community Neighborhood Watch meeting, was held at the Resource Center. Several residents attended this meeting, and we selected “**Block Captains**” for the following streets:

The role of the Block Captain is to relay information to members on their block, keeping up-to-date information on residents and ensuring the Elders, working parents, and young people are safe. Block Captains service as liaisons between the Neighborhood and the local law enforcement.

Your Block Captain, will be gathering information on each resident in the area. Block Captain’s want to make you part of your Neighborhood Watch. Block Captain’s, will be requesting information from each resident. This will help facilitate assistance if you have an Emergency and/or issue in your Neighborhood. Block Captains will answer any questions or concerns you have regarding Neighborhood Watch.

Neighborhood Watch Meetings will be held monthly. Block Captains, will distribute flyers prior to the meeting with date, time, and location.
