We ask that if your child is sick or showing any symptoms, please keep your child home. Before any child enters the center, they will be screened for their temperature and overall health. If your child has a temperature over 100.9 degrees Fahrenheit, your child will be sent home immediately.

For parents picking their child up from the center, we ask that you ring the doorbell and wait for one of our staff to meet you at the door with your child.

We will be requiring all parents to maintain up to date telephone numbers, email addresses and emergency contact numbers on file at the Education Department. Failure to keep updated information may effect your child's enrollment in the program.

The hours of operation for the Education Center are Monday – Friday: 12:45 p.m. to 5:45 p.m. with drop off starting at 5:15 p.m. – 5:45 p.m., (transportation begins 30 minutes prior to the end of center). Students will be enrolled on a 1st come; 1st serve basis. Susanville Indian Rancheria Education/Teen Center Student Rules of Conduct

(Rules have been divided in to 3 categories - major, minor & ZERO tolerance)

While participating in activities or tutoring at the Center, students must adhere to SIREC/TC Policy regarding Student Rules of Conduct. Depending on the severity of the incident, levels of discipline can be elevated and is the discretion of the SIR staff.

MAJOR OFFENSES

- 1. Fighting, Hitting, Kicking, Pushing, Biting Leaving any injury
- 2. Spitting
- 3. Unwelcomed touching
- 4. Throwing of food or objects in a violent manner
- 5. Theft
- 6. Profane abusive language or gestures
- Defiance/Disrespect, lying to or about staff or others (spreading rumors), repetitive continuous talking back.
- 8. Misuse of Susanville Indian Rancheria Education Center facilities, equipment, property or vehicles to destruction or malfunction will be dealt with as a disciplinary problem and financial responsibility will fall on the parents or guardians of the student(s) involved in the incident. Any incident that puts the safety of the student and/or others in jeopardy.
- 9. Students will not be allowed to walk home after tutoring or activities without written permission from parent or guardian. If a student has permission to walk, they are not allowed to leave without clearance from a tutor.
- 10. Students will be required to abide by the rules of any establishment that they may go to on an SIR field trip. Failure to follow this rule will jeopardize the student's further participation on field trips.

Do not send your child to center if they have the following......

- If Pink Eye is suspected, the child must be sent home and referred to their doctor for evaluation & treatment. If it is diagnosed as pink eye, they may return to school after 24 hours of treatment with appropriate medical eye drops and a note from the doctor indicating such.
- 2. Students with **draining wounds** that cannot be covered with appropriate bandages will not be allowed at the center.
- 3. If HEAD LICE is visible, students will be sent home. Upon return to the center a parent/guardian must accompany the child to clinic and have the nurse check their head for lice. If no lice are found, child may return to center with a note from the nurse. Students will not be allowed to return without a note from the nurse/doctor releasing them back to center.
- Fever of 100 and greater, the student will be sent home. They should be feverfree for 24 hours without a fever-reducing medication before the return to center.
